PREPAREDNESS FOR EVERYDAY EMERGENCIES

Before the Disaster

These are example scenarios that could happen to you at any time, anywhere in the country. Prepare yourself for these events, and if a large disaster should ever hit, you will be ready and know what to do:

- The weather is dangerous, traffic is a mess and you decide to stay with a friend instead of risking the drive home. Who will check on your cat and feed her?
- While you were out running errands, a propane truck overturned on the street near your neighborhood and you are not allowed to go home. A police officer tells you the electricity to your neighborhood was shut off. How can you make sure your birds stay warm?
- Your mother-in-law has had a heart attack and you are going to meet your wife at the hospital. It may be a long night. Who will give your dog his medicine?

The Humane Society of the United States recommends the following actions to make sure your pets are taken care of when everyday events like these prevent you from taking care of your pets:

- Find a trusted neighbor and give them a key to your house or barn. Make sure this person is comfortable and familiar with your pets.
- Make sure the neighbor knows your pets' whereabouts and habits, so they will not have to waste precious time trying to find or catch them.
- Create a pet emergency/disaster kit and place it in a prominent place where your neighbor can find it.
- If the emergency involves evacuation, make sure the neighbor would be willing to take your pets and has access to the appropriate carriers and leashes. Plan to meet at a prearranged location.
- If you use a pet sitting service, they may be available to help, but discuss the possibility well in advance.



PREPARING A DISASTER PLAN

- Talk to your veterinarian about disaster planning.
- Assemble an animal evacuation kit.
- Develop an evacuation plan for all of your animals, then practice.
- If you live in an apartment, make sure your animals are on record with management and are able to evacuate via the stairwell. Dogs should be taught to go up and down stairs to better assist rescue personnel.
- Keep written directions to your home near your telephone. This will help you and others explain to emergency responders exactly how to get to your home.
- Identify alternate sources of food and water.
- Have well maintained backup generators for use in food-animal production operations.
- Keep all vehicles well maintained and full of gas.
- Keep emergency cash on hand.

DISASTER SUPPLY CHECKLIST FOR YOUR PETS

- Food and water for at least five days for each pet.** Don't forget to bring bowls and a manual can opener if you are packing canned pet food.
- Medications and medical records for your pets.** Store these items in a waterproof container or with your pets first aid kit. A pet first aid book is also good to include.
- Cat litter box and litter.** Remember! - Garbage bags to collect all pets' waste, and litter scoop.
- Sturdy leashes, harnesses, and carriers.** Transport pets safely and ensure they can't escape. Carriers should be large enough for them to stand comfortably, turn around and lie down. Your pet may have to stay in the carrier for hours at a time. Be sure to have a secure cage with no loose objects inside it to accommodate smaller pets. These may require blankets or towels for bedding and warmth.
- Current photos and descriptions of your pets.** If you have photos with your pets, it will help others identify them in case you and your pets become separated and to prove that they are yours.
- Pet beds and toys,** if you can easily take them, to reduce stress.
- Information about your pets'** feeding schedules, medical conditions, behavior problems, and the name and number of your veterinarian in case you have to board your pets or place them in foster care.



Other useful items include newspapers, paper towels, plastic trash bags, grooming items and household bleach.

WHEN YOU EVACUATE, TAKE YOUR PETS

The single most important thing you can do to protect your pets is to take them with you. Animals left behind in a disaster can easily be injured, lost or killed. Animals left inside your home can escape through storm-damaged areas, such as broken windows. Animals turned loose to fend for themselves are likely to become victims of exposure, starvation, predators, contaminated food or water, or accidents.

Leaving dogs tied or chained outside in a disaster is a death sentence.

- ◆ If you leave, take your animals. You have no way of knowing how long you'll be gone, and you may not be able to go back for your pets.
- ◆ Leave early—don't wait for a mandatory evacuation order. An unnecessary trip is far better than waiting too long to leave safely with your pets.

If you wait to be evacuated by emergency officials, you may be told to leave your pets behind.



Don't let this happen to your pet!

IF YOU DON'T EVACUATE, SHELTER IN PLACE

If your family and pets must wait out a storm or other disaster at home, identify a safe area of your home where you can all stay together. Be sure to close your windows and doors, stay inside, and follow the instructions from your local emergency management office.

- ◆ Bring your pets indoors as soon as local authorities say there is an imminent problem. Keep pets under your direct control; if you have to evacuate. Keep dogs on leashes and cats in carriers, and make sure they are wearing identification.
- ◆ If you have a room you can designate as a "safe room," put your emergency supplies in that room in advance, including your pet's crate and supplies. Have any medications and a supply of pet food and water inside watertight containers, along with your other emergency supplies. If there is an open fireplace, vent, pet door, or similar opening in the house, close it off with plastic sheeting and strong tape.

HORSE EVACUATION TIPS

- ▶ Make arrangements in advance to have your horse trailered. Be sure you have several people on standby to help evacuate your horses.
- ▶ Make arrangements to stable your horses if needed. Contact your local animal care and control agency, agricultural extension agent, or local emergency management authorities for shelters in your area.
- ▶ Inform friends and neighbors of your evacuation plans. Post detailed instructions in several places—including the barn, tack room, horse trailer, and barn entrances—to ensure they are accessible to emergency workers in case you are not able to evacuate your horses yourself.



▶ Place your horses' Coggins tests, veterinary papers, identification photographs, and vital information—such as medical history, allergies, and emergency telephone numbers (veterinarian, family members, etc.)—in a watertight envelope.

- ▶ Keep halters ready for your horses. Each halter should include the following information: the horse's name, your name, your telephone number, and another emergency telephone number where someone can be reached.
- ▶ Be sure to have on hand a supply of water, hay, feed, and medications for several days for each horse you are evacuating.
- ▶ It is important that your horses are comfortable being loaded onto a trailer. If your horses are unaccustomed to being loaded onto a trailer, practice the procedure so they become used to it.
- ▶ There may be times when taking your horses with you is impossible during an emergency. So you must consider different types of disasters and whether your horses would be better off in a barn or loose in a field. Your local humane organization, agricultural extension agent, or local emergency management agency may be able to provide you with information about your community's disaster response plans.

FIND A SAFE PLACE AHEAD OF TIME

Because evacuation shelters generally don't accept pets (except for service animals), you must plan ahead to make certain your family and pets will have a safe place to stay. Don't wait until disaster strikes to do your research.

- ◆ Contact hotels and motels outside your immediate area to check policies on accepting pets. Ask about any restrictions on number, size and species. Inquire if the "no pet" policies would be waived in an emergency. Make a list of animal-friendly places and keep it handy.
- ◆ Check with friends, relatives or others outside your immediate area. Ask if they would be able to shelter you and your animals or just your animals, if necessary. If you have more than one pet, you may need to house them at separate locations.
- ◆ Ask your local animal shelter if it provides foster care or shelter for pets in an emergency. ***This should be your last resort***, as shelters have limited resources and are likely to be stretched to their limits during an emergency.



Make a list of boarding facilities and veterinary offices that might be able to shelter animals in emergencies; include 24-hour telephone numbers.

TRAVEL TIPS

- ◆ Ensure that your pet's identification is secure on its collar or leash. Include a phone number where you can be reached while away from home, just in case you and your pet become separated during your travels. Always keep your cell phone with you.
- ◆ Pack a fun-filled bag with familiar items. Your animal's favorite blanket, chews, treats and toys are always a great idea!
- ◆ Pets need to stretch their legs too! Let your pet out during food/fuel stops for a little exercise. Never allow your pet to roam without a leash or out of your presence.
- ◆ Don't forget your animal's food, dishes, vitamins and medications!
- ◆ Get your pet used to the car, taking shorter trips before you take longer journeys!
- ◆ When traveling buckle up your pet or use a carrier.
- ◆ It is always a good idea to carry a first aid kit for your pet: tweezers, gauze, hydrogen peroxide, etc. in case of minor injuries. For major injury/illness, you may find a comprehensive database of animal hospitals here. Pet Friendly® strongly suggests that you print out and take with you the addresses of animal hospitals in the areas you will be traveling in. Also, carry your pet's shot records with you - many hotels require proof at check-in.
- ◆ Stick to your regular feeding routine while traveling, and give your pet its main meal at the end of the day or when you've reached your destination.
- ◆ Learn more about the area you will be visiting. Your veterinarian can tell you if there are any diseases like heartworm or Lyme disease and vaccinations or medications your pet may require. Also, be aware of any unique laws. Some places have restrictions on exotic animals and certain dog breeds (pit bulls, etc.).



DISASTER PREPAREDNESS FOR HORSES

Why Horse Owners Need to Be Prepared



Disaster preparedness is important for all animals, but it takes extra consideration for horses because of their size and their transportation needs. It is imperative that you are prepared to move your horses to a safe area.

During an emergency, the time you have to evacuate your horses will be limited. With an effective emergency plan, you may have enough time to move your horses to safety. If you are unprepared or wait until the last minute to evacuate, you could be told by emergency management officials that you must leave your horses behind. Once you leave your property, you have no way of knowing how long you will be kept out of the area. If left behind, your horses could be unattended for days without care, food, or water.

Prepare a basic first aid kit that is portable and easily accessible.

AFTER THE STORM

Planning and preparation will help you survive the disaster, but your home may be a very different place afterward, whether you have taken shelter at home or elsewhere.



Don't allow your pets to roam loose.

Familiar landmarks and smells might be gone, and your pet will probably be disoriented. Pets can easily get lost in such situations.

While you assess the damage, keep dogs on leashes and keep cats in carriers inside the house. If your house is damaged, they could escape and become lost.



Be patient with your pets after a disaster.

Try to get them back into their normal routines as soon as possible, and be ready for behavioral problems that may result from the stress of the situation. If behavioral problems persist, or if your pet seems to be having any health problems, talk to your veterinarian.
